Mike Stroud is a Senior Lecturer in Medicine & Nutrition and a Consultant Gastroenterologist in Southampton. His main clinical and research interests are in intestinal failure, malnutrition & nutrition support, along with inflammatory bowel disease and he is Director of both the Southampton Nutrition Support Team and the Regional Intestinal Failure Unit. He is the immediate past Chairman of the British Association for Parenteral and Enteral Nutrition (BAPEN) and he remains their current leader on national strategies for improving nutritional care in all settings. He is the Vice Chair of the UK Department of Health Malnutrition Task Force and he leads the UK Nutrition and Hydration Action Alliance which brings together many associations and charities that are trying to improve nutritional care standards in Britain. He chaired the group that produced the UK's National Institute of Health and Clinical Excellence (NICE) 2006 Guidelines on Nutrition Support and he currently is leading the NICE work to produce guidance on IV fluid prescribing.
